5. Service Park and Stages

The Service Park is a dirt fenced area in close proximity of both the stages. Please do not use any kind of metal fasteners to the tents. Kindly follow the environmental policy and sustainability guidelines of the FMSCI and use dustbins and avoid usage of plastic disposables. Handle the oils as per the guidelines and do not dispose them into the trash cans. Please be informed that the service park main entrance lies on a Highway and hence please do not park any of your supporters' or visitors' vehicles on the highway. There is chance that these vehicles will be towed away. Please help use by cleaning your service bays of all the trash before you vacate the bays.



The service park is located about **2 kms** from Hyderabad Bengaluru Highway and is about **10 kms** from the Airport Entry Road at Shamshabad.

The following Amenities will be available at the service park:

- Allotted Service Bays on Natural Soil
- Food Stall – on chargeable basis
- Wash Rooms

JVR Stage – This stage is a private property fenced all around with no outside access except through gates. This property has a couple of lakes and some farming areas. Apart from the last years terrain of 12.30 kms we have added another 7.60 kms into a scenic area of some nice fast straights and of course a few 90 lefts and rights. This new part has Plantations so cannot avoid going through them. This stage is technical with a combination of tight loops and



some good straights. There terrain is hard packed mud terrain with no boulders or stones anywhere. The stage absolutely flat with no hills, hillocks or slopes

JJR Stage – This stage will be very similar to the other stage, only the plantations will be very less. Like the other stage there is a huge population of peacock here too. This stage is just across the other stage. There are washrooms just before the Start TC at the Gate, just in case. If you have driven the previous stage, you will feel almost the same. This stage is also absolutely flat with no hills, hillocks or slopes

12. Places to Visit in and around Hyderabad

CHARMINAR – 28 kms from Rally HQ2



Charminar is a monument and a mosque, which is synonymous with the history of Hyderabad, India. The majestic structure was completed in 1591 CE and is not only a landmark building of Hyderabad but also a famous monument of India. It is believed that Mohammed Quli Qutb Shahi, the fifth sultan of the Qutub Shahi dynasty had built the monument to commemorate the end of a deadly plague menace that had gripped the city then. It is located near the bank of the river Musi. Charminar is derived from two distinct words Char and Minar, which means four towers. Mir Momin Astarabadi of Qutb Shah dynasty played an important role and he ordered extensive preparations for the design and layout.

Historians believe that this structure is an example for Indo-Islamic architecture combined with few Persian elements. The monument is located in the heart of old city and it is believed that Hyderabad was measured in four directions from Charminar for administrative purposes.

GOLCONDA FORT – 35 kms from Rally HQ2



Golconda Fort is located in the western part of Hyderabad city and is about 9 km from the Hussain Sagar Lake. The outer fort occupies an area of three-square kilometres, which is 4.8 kilometres in length.

It was originally known as Mankal, and built on a hilltop in the year 1143. It was originally a mud fort under the reign of Rajah of Warangal. Later it was fortified between 14th and 17th centuries by the Bahmani Sultans and then the ruling Qutub Shahi dynasty. Golconda was the principal capital of the

Qutub Shahi kings. The inner fort contains ruins of palaces, mosques and a hill top pavilion, which rises about 130 meters high and gives a bird's eye view of other buildings.



Golconda fort is undoubtedly one of most magnificent fortress complexes in India. The history of Golconda Fort goes back to early 13th century, when it was ruled by the Kakatiya's followed by Qutub Shahi kings, who ruled the region in 16th and 17th century.

At Fateh Darwaza one can witness fantastic acoustical effects, which is one among the many famous engineering marvels at Golconda. Clapping your hand at a certain point near the dome entrance reverberates which is heard clearly at the hill top pavilion, almost one kilometre away. This served as a warning note to the inhabitants of the fort of any impending danger.

YADAGIRI GUTTA – 96 kms from Rally HQ2



Sri Lakshminarasimha Swamy Temple or Yadagirigutta

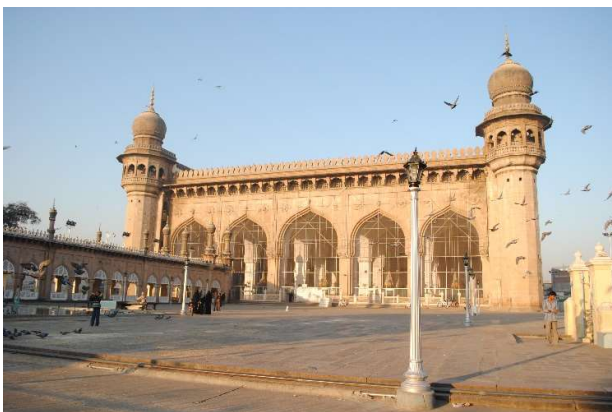
is a popular Hindu Temple devoted to Lord Narasimha Swamy, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu. It

is situated over a hillock in the Nalgonda district, Telangana at a distance of 6 km from Riagir Railway station, 13 km from Bhongir and around 60 kilometers from the capital city of Hyderabad.

Yadagirigutta is a unique and pleasant hillock that enjoys moderate climate in all seasons. The

place witnesses a heavy rush of devotees, not less than 5000-8000 pilgrims on average each day for offering their vows, performing pujas, kalyanam, abhisekam etc. while the crowd grows substantially during weekends, holidays and festivals.

According to legend in Tretayugam, there was a sage called Yadarishi, who was son of the great sage Rishyasruna and Santa Devi and performed penance inside a cave with Anjaneya's blessings. Pleased with his devotion Lord Narasimha reportedly appeared before him in five different forms namely Sri Jwala Narasimha, Sri Gandabherunda, Sri Yogananda, Sri Ugra and Sri Lakshminarasimha which later manifested into finely sculpted forms and hence it is worshiped as Pancha Narasimha Kshetram. According to Skanda Purana, there is a cave temple of Lord Vishnu where several years ago the invincible Sudharshna chakra moved in the direction like a compass guiding them towards this temple. Here Aaradhana and Puja are performed as per Pancharatra Agamam. The puja vidhanam here is done as prescribed by Late Sri Vangeepuram Narasimhacharyulu who had served as Sthanacharya of this famous temple. In 15th Century, the Vijayanagara king Sri Krishnadevaraya had mentioned about the temple in autobiography that before going to war he always visited the temple praying the lord for victory.



MECCA MASJID – 28 kms from Rally HQ2

The historic Mecca Masjid is located adjacent to Charminar in a south-west direction. The construction of this mosque

started in the year 1614 by Sultan Muhammad Qutb Shah and was Aurangzeb completed in 1693. Built with local granite, it finds place among largest mosques in India and is the most important and largest one in the city. The arched gallery displays the tombs of all the Nizam's from



the year 1803. The mosque has a length of 225 feet and is 180 feet wide with a height of 75 feet. The name is derived from the Grand Mosque in Mecca on which it is modeled. The hall has a dimension of 67 metres x 54 metres x 23 metres. The roof is rested on 15 arches.

SALARJUNG MUSEUM – 29 kms from Rally HQ2

The Museum is a royal treat for art collectors with its 43,000 art objects and 50,000 priceless books and manuscripts. The collections range from Indian Art, Middle Eastern Art, European Art, Far Eastern Art, Children Art etc. in addition to a founder’s gallery and a rare manuscript division. Indian Art forms include collections of stone sculptures, jade carvings, painted textiles, bronze images, miniature paintings, woodcarvings, modern art, textiles, metal-ware, arms & Armor, ivory carvings etc. Middle Eastern Art houses an exquisite collection of carpets, glass, furniture, metal-ware, lacquer etc. from Arabia, Persia, Syria, and Egypt. Collection of Far Eastern Art covers lacquer ware, porcelain, enamel, bronze, embroidery, wood & inlay work, paintings from Tibet, China, Japan, Nepal and Thailand etc. Oil and watercolour paintings also constitute an important part of the European Collection. It also houses the world-famous statue of Veiled

Rebecca and Marguerite and Mephistopheles, a fine collection of jade, daggers owned by Queen Noor Jahan, Emperors Shah Jahan, Aurangzeb’s sword and other timeless masterpieces.

STATUE OF BUDDHA – 36 kms from HQ2



Do you know that the Hussain Sagar Buddha statue is the tallest monolithic state of Siddhartha, also known as Gautama Buddha, the founder of Buddhism. The statue situated at the famous Lumbini Park in the Hussain Sagar Island can only be reached by boat. The Buddha Statue at Hussain Sagar in Hyderabad is an engineering marvel in that it is raised on a concrete platform, 15 feet tall, right in the middle

of the lake. Dubbed as the “Rock of Gibraltar”, the statue was erected in the middle of Lake Hussain Sagar with tremendous efforts. The city roads were widened for the construction of the statue. In the backdrop we can see the New Secretariat Building of Telangana.

from the Service Park and both the stages. It was inaugurated by Hon. Prime Minister Sri Narendra Modi. The complex around the statue has 108 temples and pujas and sevas are performed every day. As it is very close to the service park, we are

sure a few of you will take some time out to walk up to the place.

would suggest a place where you get one of the best Biryanis in the city. Hotel Shadab! Here you can also taste Haleem which is another GI Tag for Hyderabad.

Biscuits



Less known but more famous locally is **Subhan Bakery**. The Dumki Roat Biscuit is a specialty and unique here. The Osmania Biscuits melt in your mouth and Khara biscuits are best companion with a Chai
